

INTRODUCTION

Didasko Children's home was founded over 20 years ago outside of the capital city of Tegucigalpa, Honduras, to help meet the growing need to care for orphans and abused children.

About 15 years ago, Jorge Castillo left a secure job at the U.S. Embassy in Tegucigalpa, with his wife Rosa and two children, and moved to Didasko to become the directors of this vital ministry.

The average age of the children ranges from 3 to 18; however, within the last couple of years the older children, ages 16-18, are pursuing further education outside Didasko. They return on the weekends to maintain their relationship with the other children and the directors.

The children come from different backgrounds: children of prostitutes or drug addicts, some from one or both parents who are incarcerated and some who have been abused and/or neglected. Some are true orphans with no known family and some children come as siblings groups.

The goal of Didasko is to care for the children in a Christian environment, providing food, shelter, clothing, education, and Bible training. It is their desire to help the children to return to their families whenever possible, and to prepare them to become responsible members of society.

SPONSORSHIP

While Didasko is recognized by the Honduran government, they receive no support from them. They are completely dependent upon offerings and donations given by churches and individuals. The offerings and donations go towards the operation of Didasko; food, utilities, staff, maintenance, supplies, etc.

To cover the entire expense for each child would run approximately \$150 per month. However, to make it easier for sponsors to share the load, we have set up a sponsorship plan of \$25 per month. This requires more sponsors per child, but it also allows more people to become involved.

Involvement in supporting the ministry of Didasko is fulfilling and rewarding, knowing you are making a difference in the life of a child.

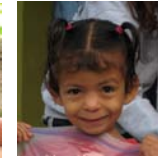
